Introduction

On July 31, the Bishops of Alberta approved a proposal by Board Chairs of Catholic organizations in the Alberta Catholic Health Corporation (ACHC) to bring 16 Catholic facilities together into one entity (one board and one administration) under the interim name of Catholic Health of Alberta. Effective August 7, a new six-member board led by W. John Brennan of Edmonton replaces the current ACHC Board of Directors.

The new organization is made up of 16 Catholic facilities in eleven communities across Alberta with almost 2,400 beds and a total budget of over \$514 million. These facilities provide a range of services—including acute care, continuing care, assisted living, hospice, rehabilitation and respite care, and seniors' housing.

The consolidation will bring together over 8,800 dedicated and passionate workers and over 2,700 volunteers.
